



## NEXT WALK

**Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2015 – Loch Kinord circular**

**Distance 15.4k Ascent 110 metres OS map 37**

We park at Cambus o' May car park (GR405981) and cross the main road (with care) to follow the Deeside Way along the sparkling (we hope) river, through the Muir of Dinnet birchwoods to Dinnet. Here we cross the main road again (with care) and head north up the A92, over a bridge, and left through a small gate. This path takes us to the north side of Clorack Loch where we pick up the main path round Loch Kinord. We turn north along this path, passing various islands and the Celtic Cross on the way to the northern end of the Loch where we turn left and head for Burn o' Vat car park and its excellent visitor centre, picnic benches and toilets. After a short detour to inspect the state of the Vat, we cross the bridge and climb up to the path which runs parallel to the burn to join a wide track where we turn left. This takes us through beautiful beech woods, and gradually descends to the Cambus o' May car park. Refreshments after the walk will be at the Loch Kinord Hotel at Dinnet. A good walk for blowing those Christmas cobwebs away!
