

Culter Hillwalking Club

NEXT WALK

Sunday 3rd January 2016

Correen Hills

Distance 10.5 kms. Ascent 330 metres OS Map 37

The walk starts at the car park on the Old Military road between Tullynessle and Clatt, NJ547232. From here we walk east past the Suie Cairn marking the parishes of Clatt, Leslie and Tullynessle and on to Suie Hill. Still heading east we drop down to a coll and then a brisk ascent up on to Knock Saul. On a clear day there are great views looking nnw to the Tap O' Noth and also west to The Buck. Dropping down off the hill we pick up a short stretch of tarmac road before we re-enter the forest and head back to the start.

This is an excellent, easy walk to kick off the New Year, and to begin shedding all those extra pounds which I am sure we have all put on over the previous couple of weeks!!

Total Time: Approx. 4 hrs

Note: This walk is classed as easy and well within all our member's capabilities. It can be rather boggy on the final homeward leg.

Meet at Culter Village Hall at 9 am, return around 4pm.

Walkers must wear walking boots (gaiters also recommended), carry WARM and waterproof clothing, hat and gloves and take plenty of food and liquids. THESE ARE ESSENTIAL. Be prepared for possible wintry conditions on the top, whatever the forecast.
